

August CLF Report

The MCAS Miramar Community Leaders Forum did not meet in August. However, the base did distribute a press release describing the deployment of VMM-162 from MCAS New River, NC to MCAS Miramar for the period August 17 to September 8.

VMM-162 operates the MV-22 “Osprey” tilt rotor aircraft. Citizens in the San Diego area can expect to see the MV-22 Ospreys in the air during that time. The aircraft will be flying along the existing flight patterns. The visit is taking place to familiarize I Marine Expeditionary Force, including the 3rd Marine Aircraft Wing, with the capabilities of the MV-22.

The next CLF meeting will be held September 6th at 10:00 a.m. Members will be afforded the opportunity to witness water survival training that is required for the Miramar pilots.
