

MIRAMAR CLF REPORT

The November Miramar CLF meeting was held on November 14th in the Commanding Officers Conference room.

The Public Affairs office outlined some of the activities they conducted during the past month. They conducted four tours for various groups, provided a Color Guard for the Military Women Annual Luncheon and coordinated a school visit for Miramar Ranch Elementary School. We did not have a formal presentation of the air operations report for the month of October. However, Mr. Tony Guinn, the Asst. Airfield Operations Officer did provide me with written statistics for the month of October. For those operations that directly affect Rancho Bernardo (the I-15 helicopter route and the Julian Jet departure route) the following may be of interest: The I-15 helicopter route experienced 362 operations and received two (2) noise complaints. The Julian jet route experienced 586 operations and received one (1) noise complaint. Total air operations for the month of October (including all routes and airfield operations) were 9,449.

The final speaker was Sergeant Major Doneil Yarn who described his experiences in the Iraq Theater. A very interesting presentation.
