There has been final approval of a SANDAG grant of \$342,000 for the River Park.

Property near Santa Rita Creek has been acquired which is connected to the Ramona Grasslands.

A letter has been received from the City of San Diego from the City Attorney for enforcement and restoration of the area near the Polo Club.
