

## **Traffic & Transportation Committee Minutes**

### **February 25, 2008**

1. Call to order at 7:00 pm. Members in attendance: Alethea Altenbern, Richard House, Dick Katz, Robin Kaufman, Kathy Keehan, Myrna Reese, Bill Renstrom, Irv Sherman, Patti Perna, Dick Walker. Members excused: Andrea Thomas. Guests: Carol Terzakis and Ellen Willis, as resident.
2. Approval of January minutes. Bill Renstrom made the motion, Dick Walker seconded. Approved: 7 Opposed: 0 Abstained: 3 (not at last meeting)
3. Potholes – Kathy Keehan updated Courtney Smith acknowledged receipt of pothole letter. City recognizes, assures repairs and entered all concerns into system. Kathy Keehan to provide update at next meeting.
4. Parlange Place – Robin Kaufman updated study pending on “no outlet” signage. Work in progress.
5. Pomerado Court/Pomerado Road – Irv Sherman updated that City Traffic Engineering advised that the intersection did not meet signal warrants. Ellen Willis, as resident, presented concerns regarding traffic light at Grandee. Concerns are that it would back up traffic to Chaparral School, backup traffic at golf course and no funding in facility finance plan. Bill Renstrom made a motion, Dick Walker seconded to request right turn only signs at both Pomerado Court and Grandee on both sides. Motion to be presented before Planning Board so that residents may have a say. Approved: 8 Opposed: 1 Abstained: 1 (not in room at time of vote)
6. Pomerado Court – Motion by Robin Kaufman, seconded by Kathy Keehan to bring fourth to the Planning Board that traffic light be placed on Pomerado Court and the Facility Finance Plan be amended. Approved: 7 Opposed: 3 Abstained: 0
7. RV Parking/Large trucks – Irv Sherman updated Courtney Smith advised that City Council approved limitations for entire City and forwarded recommendation to Mayor’s Office. Mayor’s Office has 60 days to respond.
8. W Bernardo/Frontera – Dick Walker advised that he attempted to contact resident and had not heard back. No further action.
9. New Business –
  - a. Poblado Road – Dick Katz asked about status of road repairs. Two recommendations: 1) call Councilmember Maienschein’s office to see if it is on the resurface list and 2) wait till warm/dry weather to pursue
  - b. Bernardo Heights Parkway – Robin Kaufman advised of the four deaths on Bernardo Heights Parkway between Avenida Venusto and Bernardo

Center Drive. City advised signage not warranted under Ballpark Study. Nick Anastasopoulos, VP of CABH (Community Association of Bernardo Heights), a master association of 29 HOA's and 3000 households, is issuing a letter from CABH to Councilmember Maienschein's office requesting that the City place an amber warning light using the alternative request.

- c. RB Road underpass - Alethea Altenbern request dotted lines and Kathy Keehan request bike lane under the bridge. Striping is done by Caltrans. Irv Sherman requested that email be sent to him with details of request.
