TRAFFIC & TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

MINUTES – APRIL 30, 2012

April 30, 2012

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting called to order at 7:01 pm, by Traffic & Transportation Committee Chairman Dick Katz. In attendance were Dick Katz, Joe Dirks, Richard House, Althea Altenbern, and Teri Denlinger. Absent were Robin Kaufman and Jerry Sack

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM MARCH 25, 2012:

Motion by Joe D / 2nd by Althea to approve the minutes with the correction of a typo and the identification of a portable V-tech sign. Motion passed 5-0-0

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Motion by Teri D / 2nd by Richard House to approve the agenda. Motion passed 4-0-1 (Dirks abstained because believes the agenda was not properly posted).

CHAIR REMARKS

Dick Katz noted that the city is paving the streets in RB and upgrading the handicap ramps. He spoke with TC Construction and they have a \$9 million contract for additional work.

SANDBLASTING ON BERNARDO CENTER

Dick Katz commented about the sandblasting on Bernardo Center in an effort to remove the white lines. Members concurred that the work is flawed. Mr. Dirks remarked that the black over the white paint causes the road to become slippery and harshly reflected lights.

MONITORING BERNARDO OAKS DRIVE

Dick noted that he has phoned Officer Stephan to obtain a portable speed sign. She responded that Bernardo Oaks doesn't qualify for monitoring DUIs, but committed to try and obtain the sign. Dick said he will phone the Officer to ask why the road doesn't qualify by getting specific details – what laws. Richard added that he has emailed Councilman DeMaio's office several times but has received no response. Teri committed to contact the Council office again to see what can be done.

Richard reviewed his meeting with John Gates, manager of the RB Inn, commenting that Mr. Gates stated that speed monitors had already been used on Bernardo Oaks. Richard said they were never on Bernardo Oaks. He also said that should be able to obtain stats on the number and type of accidents on this street.

There was additional discussion about the ad hoc committee that was originally created by the Planning Board and what the committee's responsibility is to the Board today. Teri said she would look into this.

SPEED HUMPS

Dick said he had called Tiffany about speed humps for Bernardo Oaks. Richard added that this road doesn't qualify because it is a major thoroughfare.

OTHER BUSINESS

No other business was discussed.

Motion to adjourn by Richard / 2nd by Joe. Unanimous.
The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
