MINUTES

- 1) **Call To Order:** Meeting was called to order 6pm by Robin Kaufman, committee chair. Committee members in attendance: Robin Kaufman, Jim Denton, Ruth Coddington, Sherry Guthrie. Excused: Mike Lutz. Residents from Bernardo Heights and the Greens East area were also present.
- 2) **Modification/Addition to Agenda:** Motion made Ruth/Sherry to accept agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously, 4-0-0.
- 3) **Resident's Remarks:** Larry Barlock requested information on the 85% rule pertaining to speeding issues on Mirasol. Larry informed us he will be meeting with representatives of the RB Inn next week in regard to various traffic issues.
- 5) **Additional Safety Measures on Bernardo Oaks Drive from RB Rd to RB Inn:** A resident at the last full board meeting requested that we look into blinking stop signs on the street. Robin informed all in attendance that the City of San Diego does not implement such signs at this time. Requests for other safety measures were suggested by the residents. These included small blinking lights on the stop sign poles, speed humps, 'residents only' signs, 'no outlet' signs, posting the 800 number for the RB Inn on the PB and RBCC websites.
- 6) **Additional Safety Measures Paseo Lucido North of Bernardo Heights Parkway:** We have requested the City not increase the speed limit on this section of the street. Discussion on various safety matters took place, which included: asking to do a walk through with a traffic engineer to see what they would suggest; more signs for pedestrian crosswalks by Fairway Heights north. It was also suggested that we inquire as to how many accidents/tickets have occurred in this area.
- 7) **Signal Sequence and Traffic Pattern Adjustment on Paseo Lucido Northbound at the Bernardo Heights Pkwy Intersection:** suggestion to make the middle lane a left turn or straight option as many already utilize it for left turns onto Bernardo Heights Pkwy. Committee chair will make this request to City traffic engineering.
- 8) **Four Way Stop at Caminito Ryone and Avenida Venusto:** The concern is increased traffic from Silvergate and the blind intersection is causing issues. Residents in attendance who live on Caminito Ryone were opposed to the stop signs and preferred a 'wait and see' approach to determine if there will be a traffic issue once Silvergate is built. The traffic committee members were all in agreement with the residents. This information will be brought to the full board.
